Our institutional framework consists of high-level metrics, encompassing groups of specific indicators, which are aligned to the key components of CI's strategy: **conservation of critical natural capital, effective governance, sustainable production, and improved human well-being**. We are implementing our framework in over 25 countries and compiling maps, datasets, and dashboards on current trends at national and subnational scales.
